Language requirement and language used in the courses	<p>In order to enjoy the stay and obtain a fair academic performance, it is very important to have enough language skills. This is why <b>students should have a Spanish level</b> equivalent to <b>B2</b> from CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).</p> <p>Classes at Faculty of Law are taught in Spanish, as well as the exams.</p>
Deadline for completed applications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- First semester and full year: <b>1-31 May, 2012</b></li> <li>- Second semester: <b>1 July – 31 October, 2012</b></li> </ul>
Application Procedure	<p>Once students have been nominated, they will be sent a link to apply online. During the application they will need to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Register as a UAM user.</li> <li>2. Fill in the Application Form.</li> <li>3. Send the Learning Agreement duly fulfilled. Once the Faculty of Law and Political Sciences has accepted the Learning Agreement, the UAM will send back an official letter of acceptance</li> <li>4. Choose the courses that they want to take.</li> </ol> <p>Upon arrival, the students will need to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Register at UAM: First semester: <b>3-5 September</b> Second semester: <b>14-16 January</b></li> <li>2. Enroll at the Faculty of Law the courses they wish to take.</li> <li>3. Start the classes the first day of the academic year, as indicated in the academic year schedule.</li> </ol>
Admission Resolution	<p>The International Relations Office of the Faculty of Law will send the students by email. Dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Non-EU students: <b>15 June</b> (1st semester and full year), <b>15 November</b> (2nd semester)</li> <li>- UE and EEE students: <b>30 June</b> (semester and full year), <b>30 November</b> (2nd semester)</li> </ul>
